



# **TFGB OPERATIONS SUPERVISOR**

The Feel Good Bakery is looking to recruit a highly motivated and hardworking individual as an Operations Supervisor for this exciting social enterprise.

The enterprise is a project created and owned by SW London charity, Regenerate, to build on their work and create employment opportunities for young people to thrive.

The Feel Good Bakery (TFGB) is a mobile coffee shop business who train, employ and mentor young people aged 16-25 who are not in education employment or training (NEET), have experienced disadvantage or are at risk of exploitation. Also for every coffee sold we provide a meal for a child in one of our partner services in Africa or Eastern Europe.

Regenerate have entered an exciting period of growth in size and impact as a charity, and this new role has been created to aid in coordinating the operations of the business. It is an exciting opportunity for an ambitious person passionate about using their skills in hospitality/business and in working with young people and young adults.

Reporting directly to the Operations and Logistic Manager for The Feel Good Bakery, the role will be responsible for maintaining the day to day running of the coffee carts across Wandsworth, providing logistical and practical support to the coffee supervisors in their roles.

## Operations (19 hours per week)

- Supervising stock levels, by completing weekly stock checks, keeping accurate records, and ordering necessary stock
- Liaising with coffee cart supervisors to manage stock levels at all sites, distributing stock using the company van.
- Maintain and develop systems and procedures to ensure the TFGB coffee shop runs efficiently and is maintained to the highest standards. Manage procedures including food hygiene (HACCP) and chemical safety (COSH).
- Work with the Operations and Logistics Manager to ensure that all procedures are complied with and standards such as Health and Safety and Food Hygiene are upheld on sites.
- Work with the Operations and Logistics Manager to shape ideas on new products to sell and help develop these.
- · Support the establishment of new mobile coffee units and sites.
- · Organise training in food hygiene for The Feel Good Bakery team members.
- Support Operations and Logistics manager in organising other training for the team where necessary.
- · Eventually train supervisors in how to work coffee units and prepare products.

## Supervision of team members on shift (18 hours per week/two shifts)

- Supervise a small team of young adults (TFGB Baristas in the coffee cart, ensuring good team morale and effective production.
- Oversee product quality and carry out quality control checks to make sure standards are maintained.
- · Carry out stock checks and keep accurate records.
- Ensure the outlet's cleanliness and hygiene standards are met each day, recorded and are kept in accordance with food safety standards.
- · Liaise with TFGB Progression Manager to feedback on team updates and development
- · Support team member's work on key learning objectives
- Ensure that the safeguarding policy is followed and all concerns reported to the managing director.
