You will support them to build positive relationships and engage with education, employment and training opportunities.

Main Responsibilities:

- Support planning and delivery of youth work sessions
- Mentor young people by building connections with them and working alongside their support networks.
- Ensure all of Regenerate & Feel Good's procedures are carried out with diligence

Mentoring and Youth Work

- Work with up to 15 mentees per term, from both the community and team members at Feel Good
- Co-develop action plans with mentees, tailored to their goals and based on an executive function skills development approach
- Collate monitoring and evaluation information regarding your mentee's progress and work plan regularly
- Work collaboratively with other organisations involved with your mentee's support network to support them effectively e.g. schools, social services, Youth Justice Service
- Support planning and delivery of up to 4 youth work sessions a week
- Support other activities or trips during holidays and occasional weekends
- Proactively engage young people and build positive relationships with them, their families and the local community
- Take responsibility to effectively manage challenging behavior, utilising your training and Regenerate's policies and procedures
- Work effectively with the team to deliver good youth work practice
- Adhere to Regenerate's code of conduct, protocols and practices when working with all young people - All necessary training will be provided

Development

- Attend supervisions to support development of reflective practice
- Participate in relevant professional development and training opportunities for your role

Internal Relations:

- Feed into team meetings to support development of the services
- Attend strategic days away/team events and contribute to the development of the organisation as a whole

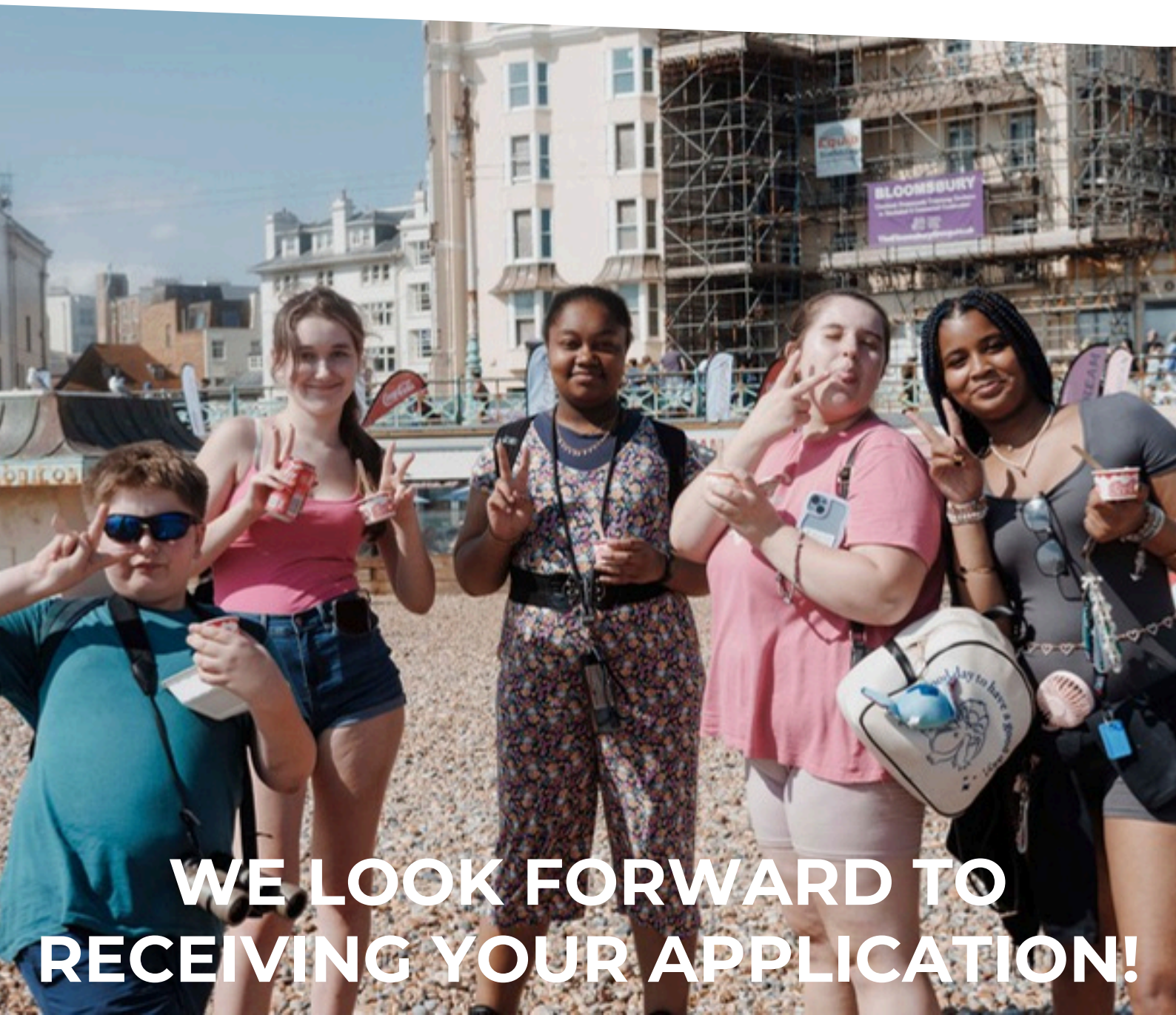
